

Hooters & Seoul Night Tour

Hooters, The country's first Hooters will open in the posh Apgujeong district in southern Seoul, making South Korea the fourth Asian destination for the Atlanta-based franchise after China, Singapore and Taiwan. The "Hooters Girls" wear tight orange shorts and white tank tops or T-shirts.

Established in 1983, Hooters operates about 440 restaurants across the U.S. and in 20 other countries, according to the company's Web site.



Seoul Tower, a landmark of the metropolitan city of Seoul, is introduced with its new name and look to provide more fun and excitement.

It is viewable from almost anywhere in Seoul and serves as an excellent landmark. A 852 feet high peak in Namsan Park, the tower reaches to 157 feet above sea level. When the weather and pollution levels cooperate, visiting the observation tower (1213 feet above sea level) allows you to view the entire city and surrounding areas.

Because of the great view, many people enjoy climbing up here for early morning exercise or for a romantic stroll after dark.



Itaewon is a special tourism zone that stretches all the way past the Hamilton Hotel to Hannam-dong. It is honeycombed with about 2,000 shops as well as jazz bars, nightclubs and ethnic restaurants. This district is popular with both foreign residents and tourists. In the core area around the Hamilton Hotel are clustered 1,000 shops selling leather goods, bags, clothes, shoes and tourist souvenirs. The sidewalk is fringed with about 400 roadside stalls attracting shoppers with accessories, hats, T-shirts, small gadgets and much more. Itaewon is the area most densely packed with diverse ethnic restaurants, such as Italian, Swiss, German, Mexican, Indian, Pakistani, and Thai.
