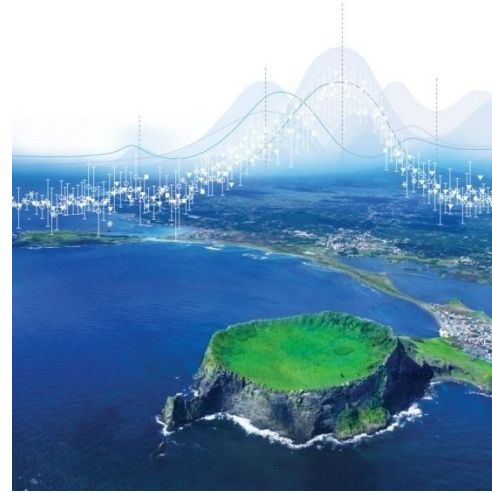


Jeju Island

Jeju Island (Jejudo) known as a place of fantasy or mystery is the largest island in Korea and is located in the southwest sea of the Korean peninsula and highlighted for its uniqueness. It is the only special self-governing province of South Korea. The size of Jeju is 45.6 miles from east to west, 25.6 miles from north to south in the shape of an oval. The island has an area of 719.5 sq. miles with a circuit road of 116.8 miles along the seashores. Its population is about 530,000.

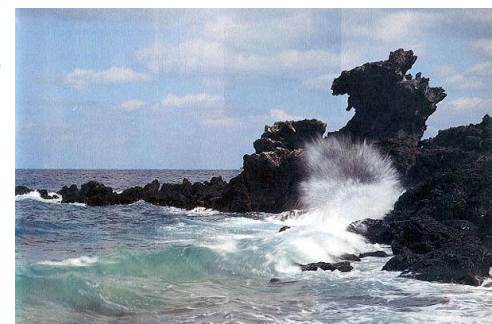
In the center of the island sits Halla mountain which was a volcano once rising 1.22 miles above sea level. About 360 smaller cones named "Orum" around the island show a peculiar topographical view in combination with Halla mountain. It is influenced by the oceanic climate in summer and continental climate in winter. Weather is very mild with an average temperature of about 61°F.

Various kinds of plants from polar plants to subtropical plants are seen here a treasure house of approximately 1,800 different vegetation. It holds rich underground resources, and every kind of fish and corals in the clean blue sea area. Jeju is a tourist resort. Many people visiting this blessed island from many countries have helped to make it an international tourist resort.



Yongduam Rock

At the western end of Jeju City, where the Hanch'on stream runs into the ocean, is a large rock formation shaped like a dragon's head. A short trail has been carved out going down the cliffs to give several views of the rock. Several old women sell fresh seafood in the area. Legend states that the Dragon King's messenger was sent to Halla Mountain to gather *bulloch'o* (an herb reputed to give eternal life). The messenger was killed by an arrow from an angry mountain god. Part of the messenger's body sank into the water while the head remained above the water, trying to return to the sky. On windy days, the waves crashing against the rocks suggest the fury of the dragon.



Seongsan Ilchulbong (Sunrise Peak)

Many tourists regard Seongsan Ilchulbong (Sunrise Peak) as the most impressive tourist site on Jeju Island. It should be noted that people who have not seen the sun rise still choose the site as the best place. In order to watch the sunrise from Seongsan which is located at the east most of Jeju Island, accommodations should be arranged private residences or lodging facilities. Get up early in the morning and climb up to the summit to feel the ecstasy of the sunrise. The real value of Seongsan Ilchulbong, unable to be described in words, can be actually felt.



Jeongbang Waterfall

With Seopseom and Beomseom Island in front, the Jeongbang Waterfall is right at the edge of the ocean. The Jeju people believed that a holy dragon lived under the waterfall. It has been said that since the water has its spirit, it has cured illnesses and caused rain to fall during a drought. In addition, there is another small waterfall nearby, looking like a servant waiting on a dignified lord. That's why it was chosen as one of the scenic wonders of Jeju among other big waterfalls in Jeju.



Hallim Park is strongly scented with exotic sentiment. The plants are divided into 16 sectors including the Tropical Botanical Garden, Washingtonian Palm Garden, Foliage Plant Garden, Palm Tree Garden, and Kiwi Fruit Garden. The most famous tourist sites in Hallim Park are Hyeopjae Cave and Ssangyong Cave. In addition, a folk village, children's amusement park, and outdoor resort facilities make it a place enjoyable for both children and adults.



The Jusangjeolli are stone pillars piled up along the coast and is a designated cultural monument of Jeju Island. The Jusangjeolli was formed when the lava from Mt. Hallasan erupted into the sea of Jungmun. They are rock pillars shaped like cubes or hexagons of various sizes and almost seem as if stonemasons had carved them out. Its 20 m cliff makes it a popular spot for high tide, sea angling. The waves of the high tides crashing into the side of the cliff provide a breathtaking view of the ocean surrounding the pillars.
