

# Sudoksa Temple & Onyang Folk Museum

**Sudoksa** is the one of the main temples of Korea, where there is a comprehensive training center comprised of a meditation of a monks' college and a center for studying monks' rule. It was founded by Master Sungje in the late Paekche period. The Main Hall is a shrine to an important triad. It was built in 1308 and it is nothing short of a miracle that building has stood through successive invasions in which everything of any value seems to have been destroyed. The beauty of this building derives from the balance of the whole design. Its history and style have caused it to be regarded as a masterpiece of Koryo Dynasty architecture.



**Onyang Folk Museum** is composed of two buildings; the main building with four exhibition halls and a cultural center. The museum exhibits folk materials, relics, and traditional implements. The museum is frequented not only by general viewers but also by professional researchers on Korean folk culture. Various events and wedding ceremonies are held at the cultural center. Many prospective couples line up to have a traditional wedding on weekends
