III. Opening Remarks: The meeting opened with an introduction and agenda review by Col McKibban. The 51 FW will host monthly town hall meetings on the second Tuesday of every month to promote improved communication to the base community.

IV. Agenda

- a. Communication Action Plan (CAP) Briefed by Col McKibban: The CAP was developed to provide open, honest, consistent, and relevant communication at deliberate moments to improve readiness & quality of life for Team Osan Airmen & families. It will be implemented through 3 Lines of Effort (LOEs).
 - i. LOE 1: Mustang One-Stop. A single source of information for use by all members of Team Osan.
 - ii. LOE 2: Improved/Updated Touchpoints. Improving existing meetings and events to meet consumer's needs.

- iii. LOE 3: Synchronized & Standardized Messaging. Ensuring official (command channels) and unofficial (FB, etc.) match in message and intent. Strengthening Command Channel communications.
- b. Mustang One-Stop Demo Briefed by Maj Gray: The Mustang One-Stop is intended to be your primary source of info and will go live by the end of the month. It will be accessible from the main Osan AB webpage and from the 51 FSS webpage. More info will follow when it is officially rolled out. Team Osan was requested to use, promote, and provide feedback on this product to help ensure it's as successful as possible.
 - i. Question: Will the website include a base calendar of events to centralize the base happenings?Answer: The team identified the same need and is working to find a way to
 - incorporate this as an addition after initial roll-out.ii. **Question**: Will Private and Non-Private organization info be included?
 - 11. Question: Will Private and Non-Private organization into be included? Answer: Official organizations are represented. The desire for PO information is understand and the team is looking at options to capture them without inadvertently favoring or promoting some over others.

 - i. **Question:** Where can non-military access the new regulation? **Answer:** SFS provided pamphlets at meeting with key info. SFS is coordinating with PA to push the document to the base on appropriate platforms.
 - ii. Question: Do bikes count for the 2-wheeled vehicle limitation? Answer: No, the limit only applies to motorized (electric or fuel) 2-wheel vehicles.
- e. Universal Pre-K– Briefed by Ms. April Kersey (School Liaison Program Manager): Registration for 2024-2025 school year begins in April. More info to come.
- f. Medical Services Briefed by Lt Col Varney (Chief Nurse): The Patient & Family Partnership Council was developed to bring MDG and "customers" together to provide more feedback to DHA. The meeting is help the 3rd Friday of every month in Bldg 777 (Clinic).
- g. Force Support Briefed by Lt Col Hill (FSS Commander): Feb 26th, FSS will unveild a new indoor child play area in Checkertails. The new CDC/SAC facility will open in the fall and greatly increase the base's childcare capacity.

Traffic & Parking Policy Updates

CUI

- New OSANABOI 31-128 effective 01 Feb 2024
- Major Changes
 - All vehicles, including PTDs, must be registered
 - Unaccompanied E-6 & below No "restricted area" parking M/F, 0600-1800
 - Reserved parking spaces effective 24/7
 - 3 parking tickets = loss of driving privileges for 1 year
 - Authorized vehicle limitations
 - One (1) 4-wheeled vehicle per household
 - One (1) 2-wheeled vehicle per licensed driver
 - Dash cameras are prohibited on-base
 - ETPs approved by MSG/CD
 - Note: Not between white lines, not a parking spot!
 - Except in gravel lots

Universal Pre-K

- Registration opens April for 2024-2025 School Year
- CDC wrap-around care available for families needing before or after school care
- FW & DoDEA working to ensure transportation for families that live in the off-post commuting zone
 - DoDEA will provide child safety seats and bus attendants
- FW & DoDEA are analyzing current zoning to verify/adjust zones and bus routes
 - Estimated study complete April 2024 with phased adjustments to maximize resources


