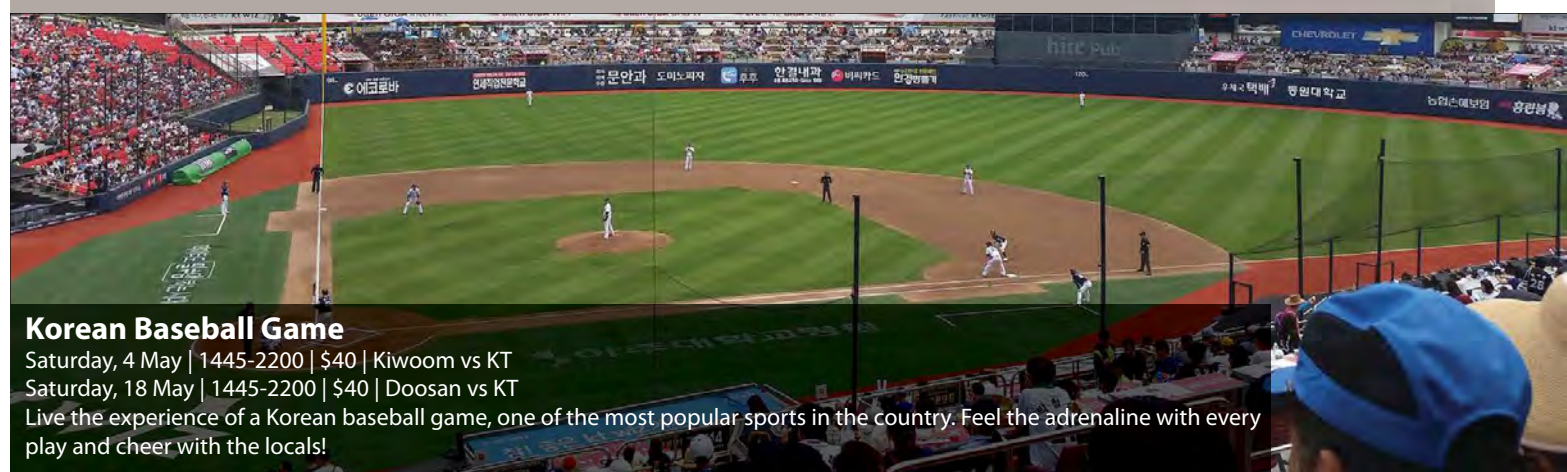

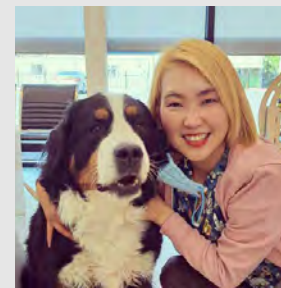

# BEYOND THE UNIFORM:

## Recognizing the Strength of Military Spouses

Being a Military Spouse is an experience full of rewarding memories, challenging times, and stressful moments, but it could be one of the greatest adventures and enriching experiences. We have to become more independent; it is not a choice, it is a given. We hold down the fort while the spouse goes off to work, on duty, or off to deployment. We care for the house, the kids, the family, finances, and everything else life throws at us. I take it as a new task, some as a walk in the park, others like the world is ending, but finally, we take it and strive. We always do.

The military community is a lifestyle characterized by frequent moves, deployments, and unique challenges. Living overseas is a whole new journey compared to living in the United States. It offers an opportunity to learn a new culture, new language, try different foods, and travel to new places. Getting used to a different time zone and a new lifestyle could be tough and exciting. South Korea is so different from American culture that we sometimes find things that the locals are used to, as a shock. For example, getting around the country is easy, affordable, and convenient. It's common to find individuals confidently leaving their belongings like computers and phones unattended in cafes, and walking around at night feels safe.

Osan Air Base is a one-of-a-kind air base. Military spouses come here for usually a two-year tour, making Osan a harmonious and active community. This base offers many activities and facilities to make life easier for military families. Sometimes you may feel lonely or face long periods of separation but know that you are never alone. Making friends could be difficult, but it is always a relief to know you can rely on someone even when you don't have family around.

For Jessica Smith, a Military Spouse living at Osan, it's a big change. "It's a little harder in Korea because of the language. I enjoy the culture, exploring, and getting lost trying to find our way back home," she laughed. Jessica and her husband have been living in South Korea for almost two years and they are thinking of extending one more year. "I love that my girls get to see the world and connect with people that they would never meet," she added. Her dad was a firefighter growing up, so she is used to this kind of lifestyle. Jessica has been a Military spouse for 12 years and Osan is her husband's third duty station.

Her mother taught her how to handle difficult situations when a parent is not present all the time. "I don't love the problems that sometimes come with it, but for the most part it is really fun and exciting," she expressed. When we become a military spouse, we have no idea of what's to come. We start looking for resources and ask other spouses to get information, if we don't, we may get lost, between waiting and wondering. We need to be creative and figure out ways to work through it all. Jessica found her support from other moms going through a similar experience. "Find other moms. You need to find someone that knows what you're going through. It's hard to do, but it's incredibly helpful." Jessica advises other Military Spouses to: "Get out and explore, don't stay home all day because that is when it gets scary and hard. Experience South Korea!" she concluded.



Military Active Duty moms are very resilient, especially when they face the challenges of living overseas, enduring long workdays, temporary duty assignments (TDY), or deployments. Establishing a good support system is key to overcoming the daily basics. Master Sergeant Whitney O'Neill, a mother and military spouse stationed at Osan Air Base with her family, shuffles between being a service member, a wife, and a mom every day. "It's like being constantly deployed because you work non-stop. I do my regular job and then I go home to do my parenting job," she said.

Her primary support is her mother who lives here with her, and assists with childcare. Stationed at Osan, it's unique for MSgt O'Neill and her family. "My husband works here too; he sacrificed his career to have better hours and be home with the children." She added since her kids are still young, they are going to see the rewards of these sacrifices in the future. "Someday they are going to look back and say oh wow that was a very cool thing." Despite all the challenges, they find joy in family moments outside of work, taking advantage of the many things Osan and Korea have to offer. "The host nation loves children and we love living here with kids. The restaurants have playgrounds, the base has playgrounds everywhere and my kids enjoy it very much," she commented.

If you want to try a new video game, you can check it out at the Library. If you want to meet new people and have a nice evening, you can also join the book club, which meets once a month.

Since the recipient country may have restrictions on what can be imported, mail pieces addressed to a military destination must include a properly completed PS Form 2976 or PS Form 2976-A.



Package weighs LESS than 1 lb (16 oz)

Use PS Form 2976 (and Customs Declaration and Dispatch Note - CP 72)



Package weighs MORE than 1 lb (16 oz)

Use PS Form 2976-A (and Customs Declaration CN 22)

First-Class Letters, Large Envelopes or Priority Mail Flat Rate Envelopes that weigh under 16 ounces DO NOT require Customs Forms.

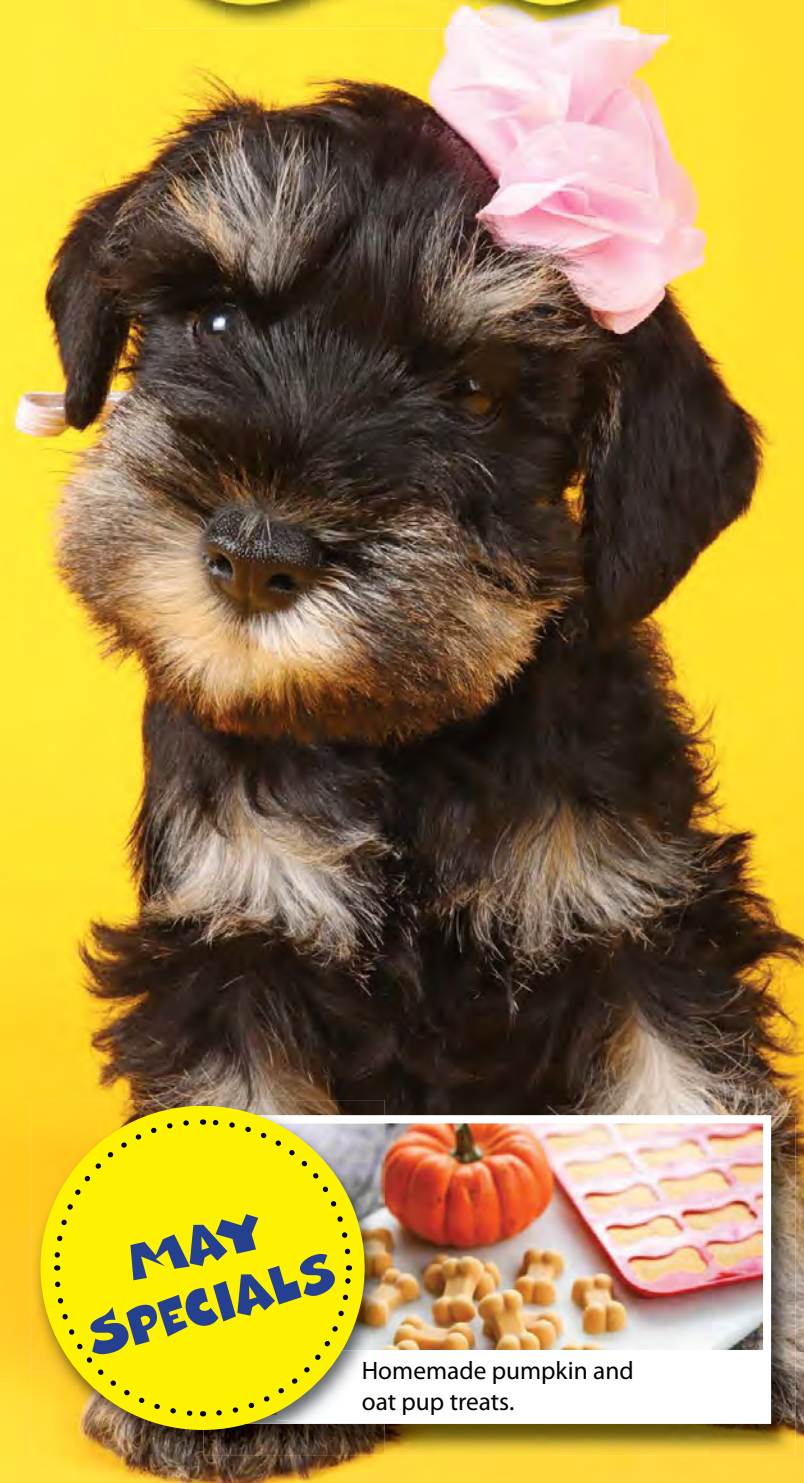
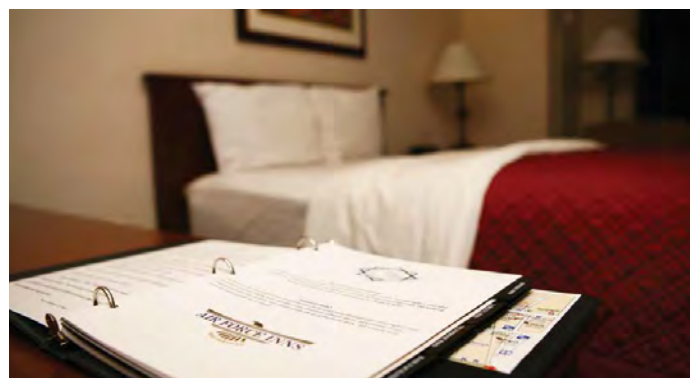
