SUBJECT: Osan Dining Facility Dress Code

1. This letter outlines the dress and appearance standards for all personnel utilizing Osan AB military dining facilities. The policies described below are necessary to maintain health and sanitation standards as well as presentation of a professional image ensuring good order and discipline.
2. Any military uniform combination is appropriate for wear. Military uniforms will comply with the standards outlined in the applicable service directives.
 - a. Physical Training uniforms may be worn provided they are not obviously soiled, sweat-soaked or otherwise presenting an unclean appearance.
 - b. Coveralls are authorized for wear by maintenance personnel in the Back of the Hanger Dining Facility. Items will not be obviously soiled, dirty, or greasy.
3. Safety equipment such as helmets and reflective vests must be worn when operating a two-wheeled vehicle. Both must be removed immediately after dismounting and replaced with uniform headgear.
4. Civilian clothing will keep with high standards of appearance, cleanliness, and dignity. The following types of civilian apparel are prohibited:
 - a. Any clothing obviously soiled, sweat-soaked or presenting an unclean appearance.
 - b. Civilian headgear of any kind (except food service workers).
 - c. Bathing or swimming suits worn as an outer garment or fishnet and see-through clothing.
 - d. Bare feet, shower shoes, or metal/rubber shoes with cleats or spikes.
 - e. The wear of pants or jeans not in accordance with the manufacturers intended wear. (e.g. hanging from the bottom of the human buttock area is prohibited). Additionally, exposure of undergarments due to sagging pants at anytime is prohibited.
 - f. Any article of clothing with obscene or profane pictures/language, or articles indicating blatant disrespect for the U.S. Government or instrumentalities.
